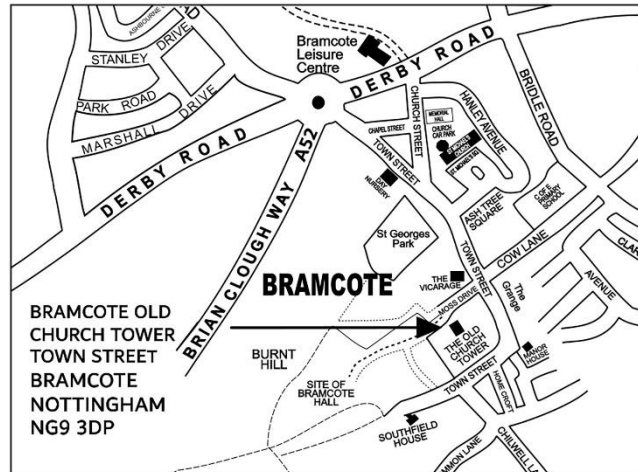


EVENTS PROGRAMME 2021

The Tower Project started in 2004, when the Friends of Bramcote Old Church Tower began the task of restoration of the 13th century, grade II listed church tower and the respectful regeneration of the closed and deconsecrated graveyard.

In 2010 Bramcote Old Church Tower Trust was formed and in 2015 an application for Heritage Lottery Funding was made. In 2017 it was granted and the work is on-going. The site is of historical importance locally and no longer associated with the church, but a public space for the community at the centre of the village of Bramcote.
